



BACKGROUND

The decision to construct a new school in the village of Debet was prompted by the dilapidated state of the existing building, which posed seismic risks. Demolition of the old structure took place in 2022, and plans are currently underway to construct a school from the ground up. This project is part of COAF's SMART Village initiative, which aims to rejuvenate the community of Debet, consisting of 820 residents and home to the cutting-edge SMART Center. Once finished, the school will serve as the primary educational institution for elementary, junior high, and high school students in Debet.

In addition to the physical infrastructure, COAF is committed to enhancing the curriculum and ensuring quality education by investing in comprehensive teacher training. This initiative aims to equip educators with the necessary skills and knowledge to deliver engaging and effective lessons, fostering a stimulating learning environment for the students of Debet.

DESCRIPTION



Recognizing the importance of physical activity, an open-air sports ground and playground will be available for children to engage in play and athletic activities.
